First aid measures

General	Contaminated clothing must be taken off immediately.
Skin	Remove any contaminated clothing immediately. Wipe of mechanically and
contact	wash affected areas thoroughly with soap and water or with a cleanser based on
	polyethylene glycol for at least 15 minutes.
	Contaminated clothing should not be reused . For severe exposures, the
	affected person should get under a safety shower, using the flushing action of
	the water to remove the bulk of the chemical, then remove contaminated
	clothing and wash skin with soap and water. Seek medical attention. For lesser
	exposures, the individual should seek medical attention if irritation develops or
	persists after the area is washed.
Inhalation	The person should move to an area free from risk of further exposure. Oxygen
	or artificial respiration should be administered as needed. Asthmatic-type
	symptoms may develop and may be immediate or delayed up to several hours.
	Treatment is essentially symptomatic. A physician should be consulted.
Eye	Flush with large amounts of lukewarm water for at least 15 minutes, holding
contact	eyelids open all the time. Refer the affected individual to an eye specialist or
-	other physician for immediate follow-up.
Ingestion	The person should drink 1 to 2 cups of water. Vomiting should not be induced
	and nothing should be given orally to an unconscious or convulsing person. A
	physician should be consulted.
